FINDINGS: No soft tissue mass or adenopathy is identified within the neck. The parotid and submandibular glands are normal bilaterally. The thyroid gland is unremarkable. Bone windows are grossly unremarkable other than some mild facet degenerative changes on the left. There is a small retention cyst or polyp along the posterior aspect of the right maxillary sinus.
